When I was elected to the California State Assembly, one of the first issues I started working on was making diapers more affordable and accessible to parents. Diaper need was a public health issue long before the COVID-19 crisis, with one in three American families struggling to afford diapers that can cost up to \$ 100 per child every month.

The existing diaper need crisis in the US has now reached an emergency level, according to the National Diaper Bank Network.
